Purposes and retention and legal grounds

Browsing data

Data processed are IP addresses and the domain name of users' PCs, the date and time of the connection and other data about the operating system and the environment of the user.

Legal ground is:

- processing is necessary in order to take steps at the request of the data subject prior to entering into a contract;
- the legitimate interest of the controller (i.e. having statistics on the use of the website and controlling the correct use of the website);
- consent of the data subject on the banner; the consent is needed for gathering more performance and analytics data; we need to gather personal data for having better analysis not of the data subject behaviour, but of the service.

Other details are in the Cookie policy.

Contributions to projects and initiatives

Site visitors can leave contributions to projects and initiatives. For this reason, it's required to them leave their identification data in order to ensure a higher quality of contributions.

Moreover, if other initiatives will be planned, visitors can subscribe to them and for this reason it is always necessary to provide your identification data.

The identification data are visible on the website itself.

Presentation data

Site visitor can voluntary give data to the website about their professional profile. This is for facilitating contacts among users of the website.

Legal ground is the provision of a service requested by the data subject.

Data will be retained until the data subject requires their deletion or the data controller closes the website.

Data are made public for the purpose of creating project groups to respond to calls, competitions or other similar initiatives. In this case, the participants can contact each other to evaluate the possibility of creating a project team.

In some cases, the data of the members of the group are communicated to other organizations or promoters or auctioneers of the initiative, as data controller for the purposes related to the initiative itself.

In this case, the transfer of data to another controller is made explicit by the initiative page and the information from the recipient controller will be available on his website (Ordine degli Architetti di Milano, if possible, inserts the direct link to this information).

In the case of insertion of already established groups, the group leader has the responsibility to inform the other participants of this initiative.

The data of the participants are kept by the Order until 10 years after the closing of the call, in order to demonstrate the correct execution of the activities.

Transfers to other parties and third Countries

For the above purposes, the data controller may transfer personal data to external legal entities or people.

External providers and suppliers agreed, with written contracts, to process data only for the stated purposes and adopt suitable security measures and processing controls.

Data are not transferred in third Countries. If this is done, it will be done according to the requirements of applicable laws.

Data subject rights

Data subjects have specific rights. Among them:

- the right to obtain from the controller confirmation as to whether or not personal data concerning him or her are being processed, and, where that is the case, access to the personal data, their rectification and erasure, the restriction of their processing; requests of erasure and restriction will imply the ending of the service;
- the right to send a complaint to the data controller or the Data protection authority (in Italy it is the Garante per la protezione dei dati personali).
